## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Herman Douglas Everett and dedicating a road in his memory; and  
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Herman Douglas Everett has long been recognized by the citizens of this  
4 state for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to  
5 the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Everett graduated from Sylvester High School and attended the Georgia  
7 Institute of Technology and Georgia Southern University; and

8 WHEREAS, he was the founder and president of Southern Appraisal Company, where he  
9 appraised commercial real estate for over 30 years; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Everett's leadership was instrumental to organizations such as the Albany  
11 Planning and Zoning Commission and the Albany City Commission, where he served as  
12 mayor pro tem for two terms; and

13 WHEREAS, he was elected to the Georgia House of Representatives in 1996 before serving  
14 on the Georgia Public Service Commission for almost two decades; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished  
16 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his memory.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
18 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 133 from State Route 112 to  
19 Bridgeboro-Anderson City Road in Worth County is dedicated as the Doug Everett Memorial  
20 Highway.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
22 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Doug Everett Memorial  
23 Highway.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
25 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
26 family of Mr. Herman Douglas Everett and to the Department of Transportation.
