A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Mr. Eric Wilmarth and dedicating a roundabout in his honor; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Eric Wilmarth has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the
4 vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare
5 of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by his superlative service as the Ball Ground City Manager; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Wilmarth's significant organizational and leadership talents, remarkable
10 patience and diplomacy, keen sense of vision, and sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of
11 this state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

12 WHEREAS, under his management, Ball Ground was able to revitalize the sewer systems,
13 supporting both economic and environmental sustainability, while never utilizing the powers
14 of eminent domain; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
16 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a roundabout in his honor.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
18 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the State Route 5BU and Howell Bridge Road roundabout
19 in Cherokee County is dedicated as the Eric W. Wilmarth Roundabout.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
21 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Eric W. Wilmarth
22 Roundabout.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
24 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Mr.
25 Eric Wilmarth and to the Department of Transportation.
