## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the establishment of Ms. UNGLOBAL Peace Ambassador; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives recognizes the increasing global need for  
4 diplomacy, peace-centered leadership, and international collaboration in a time marked by  
5 division and social fragmentation; and

6 WHEREAS, women across nations continue to serve as catalysts for reconciliation,  
7 humanitarian advancement, and cross-cultural engagement; and

8 WHEREAS, the initiative known as Ms. UNGLOBAL Peace Ambassador has been  
9 established as a distinguished global leadership platform designed to recognize and activate  
10 women committed to advancing peace, justice, and ethical governance; and

11 WHEREAS, this initiative is being advanced in collaboration with: United Nations Global  
12 Awards Corp.; United Nations Global Women Foundation Corp.; Trinity Girls Network  
13 Corp., a nonprofit organization holding Consultative Status with the United Nations  
14 Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC); Trinity International University of Ambassadors

15 (Florida); and The Organization of World Leaders, a global leadership coalition dedicated  
16 to advancing international dialogue, cooperation, and ethical governance; and

17 WHEREAS, these collaborating entities collectively promote education, humanitarian  
18 advancement, women's leadership development, and cross-border engagement.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body recognize Ms. UNGLOBAL Peace Ambassador as a distinguished  
21 global leadership initiative committed to advancing peace diplomacy and international  
22 collaboration.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that recipients of this designation shall serve as advocates  
24 for unity, reconciliation, and humanitarian service within their communities and international  
25 spheres of influence.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body commends the collaborating organizations for  
27 their commitment to fostering peace-centered leadership and global partnership.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
29 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to United  
30 Nations Global Awards Corp., United Nations Global Women Foundation Corp., Trinity  
31 Girls Network Corp., Trinity International University of Ambassadors (Florida), and The  
32 Organization of World Leaders.
