A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the Carroll Electric Membership Cooperative upon its 90th anniversary; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, established in 1936, the Carroll Electric Membership Cooperative has provided
4 its members with safe, reliable, and affordable power for the last 90 years; and

5 WHEREAS, this distinguished organization was formed following the creation of the Rural
6 Electrification Administration by President Franklin D. Roosevelt and spearheaded by Robert
7 D. Tisinger, who led the electrification movement in West Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, on July 31, 1937, its first section of line provided power to 344 members, and
9 as of today, the Carroll Electric Membership Cooperative serves more than 56,000 members
10 across Carroll, Haralson, Heard, Paulding, Polk, Troup, and Floyd counties; and

11 WHEREAS, through more than 5,500 miles of line and 25 substations, the Carroll Electric
12 Membership Cooperative continues to enhance the quality of life and provide innovative
13 solutions for the communities it serves; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable cooperative be
15 appropriately honored during this special time.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body congratulate the Carroll Electric Membership Cooperative upon
