14 in A Newspaper circulation under 150,000; and

15 WHEREAS, she has continuously gone above and beyond in her pursuits to empower the
16 people of Georgia through truth, storytelling, and transparent reflections of the lives' of
17 everyday Georgians; and

18 WHEREAS, Maya is the embodiment of integrity, excellence, and esteemed character, and
19 her work is a reflection of courageous and groundbreaking journalism; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
21 remarkable and distinguished journalist be appropriately honored.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
23 recognize and commend Maya T. Prabhu for her time, dedication, and excellent work with
