

**ADOPTED**

Senators Robertson of the 29th and Strickland of the 42nd offered the following amendment #2:

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on Public Safety substitute to SB 482 (LC 62 0415S) by*  
 2 *inserting after "changes;" on line 6 "to provide for the public disclosure of certain records*  
 3 *of the General Assembly; to provide for application; to provide for construction;"*

4 *By replacing line 38 with the following:*

5 Said chapter is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

6 "50-18-79.

7 (a) If any claim of an unlawful employment practice made against the General Assembly,  
 8 the House of Representatives, the Senate, or any member, office, or employee thereof,  
 9 including, but not limited to, a claim of sexual harassment, discriminatory harassment,  
 10 discrimination, or retaliation, is resolved in whole or in part by a settlement agreement, a  
 11 memorandum of agreement or understanding, or other similar document, however  
 12 denominated, such agreement shall be subject to public disclosure with the claimant's  
 13 identity redacted. For purposes of this subsection exclusively, the General Assembly shall  
 14 be an agency. This subsection shall be applied retroactively.

15 (b) Except as provided for in subsection (a) of this Code section, nothing in this Code  
 16 section shall be construed or applied so as to subject the General Assembly to the  
 17 provisions of Code Sections 50-18-70 through 50-18-78 or Chapter 14 of this title."

**SECTION 3-A.**

- 19 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
