4 public service professional whose life exemplifies integrity, compassion, and unwavering
5 commitment to others; and

6 WHEREAS, for more than 30 years, she faithfully served the citizens of Georgia through her
7 distinguished career with the Fulton County Superior Court, demonstrating professionalism,
8 respect for justice, and a deep commitment to public service before retiring with honor; and

9 WHEREAS, for over 17 years, Micah Robinson-Womack has been an extraordinary leader
10 within the Atlanta Area Council of Scouting, serving in numerous capacities and currently
11 holding the esteemed position of Commissioner for the Southern Crescent District, where she
12 mentors volunteers, strengthens units, and uplifts youth across the district; and

14 recognized with some of the organization's highest honors, including the Whitney M. Young

15 Jr. Service Award, the Silver Beaver Award, and the District Award of Merit, reflecting her
