

## Senate Resolution 932

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing United States Treasurer Brandon L. Beach and dedicating a road in his honor;  
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, United States Treasurer Brandon L. Beach has long been recognized by the  
4 citizens of this state for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal  
5 commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he served the people of Georgia with distinction for over two decades, having  
7 been elected to the Georgia State Senate in 2013 representing District 21; and

8 WHEREAS, Treasurer Beach held several influential positions in the Senate, including  
9 Chairman of the Senate Transportation Committee, where he was instrumental in advancing  
10 transportation and infrastructure reforms critical to Georgia's economic growth and global  
11 competitiveness, and Chairman of the Senate Economic Development and Tourism  
12 Committee, where he focused on fostering a business friendly environment in this state; and

13 WHEREAS, Treasurer Beach served as the executive director and founder of the North  
14 Fulton Improvement District and has held key leadership roles with the Georgia Regional

15 Transportation Authority, the Georgia Department of Transportation, and the Fulton County  
16 Development Authority; and

17 WHEREAS, he was appointed by President Donald J. Trump to serve as the United States  
18 Treasurer, a role in which he oversees the nation's financial operations, manages the U.S.  
19 Mint and Fort Knox, and advises on matters of fiscal policy; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished  
21 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his honor.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
23 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 9 from Old Milton Parkway to  
24 Mayfield Road in Fulton County is dedicated as the United States Treasurer Brandon L.  
25 Beach Highway.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
27 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the United States Treasurer  
28 Brandon L. Beach Highway.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
30 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to United States  
31 Treasurer Brandon L. Beach and to the Department of Transportation.
