A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating and commending Ms. Sharon J. Hill for receiving the 2026 Yellow Rose
2 Nikki T. Randall Servant Leadership Award; and for other purposes.

4 female elected to the General Assembly from middle Georgia, and over her 17 years of
5 service as a legislator, she held numerous leadership positions, including chair of the Georgia
6 Women's Legislative Caucus; and

7 WHEREAS, every year during Women's History Month, the Georgia Women's Legislative
8 Caucus recognizes outstanding women in Georgia who exemplify the leadership and
9 inspiration embodied by Representative Randall; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Sharon J. Hill is a devoted community leader and tireless advocate for
11 social justice and voting rights; and

12 WHEREAS, she previously served as a media relations strategist and publicist for Senator
13 Donzella James and has contributed her expertise to numerous other distinguished political
14 campaigns and offices throughout the State of Georgia; and

15 WHEREAS, she has held various leadership roles within her community, including service
16 with the NAACP and the League of Women Voters of Georgia, among many other
17 prestigious organizations; and

18 WHEREAS, her outstanding work has earned her recognition throughout the State of
19 Georgia, including being named the 2021 United Nations Human Rights Ambassador by
20 Trinity University, the 2020 Woman of Action by the League of Women Voters Marietta-
21 Cobb County, the 2019 Cobb County NAACP MLK Day "Living the Dream" Award, and
22 numerous other distinguished honors; and

23 WHEREAS, Ms. Sharon J. Hill is a woman of unassuming greatness whose humble acts of
24 kindness and generosity have uplifted her entire community; and

25 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
26 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
28 congratulate and commend Ms. Sharon J. Hill for receiving the 2026 Yellow Rose Nikki T.
29 Randall Servant Leadership Award and extend best wishes for her continued success.
