- 1 Recognizing Georgia HBCU and Divine Nine Day; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) have played a vital role
3 in expanding educational opportunities, leadership development, and community
4 advancement for generations of students; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the nine historically Black Greek-letter organizations known as the Divine Nine
6 have contributed significantly to scholarship, public service, civic engagement, and
7 leadership throughout Georgia and the nation; and
- 8 WHEREAS, graduates and members of these institutions and organizations continue to
9 strengthen communities through education, mentorship, professional excellence, and service;

- 11 WHEREAS, Georgia is proud to be home to several distinguished HBCUs whose impact
12 reaches far beyond their campuses.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
14 recognize Georgia HBCU and Divine Nine Day in honor of the legacy, achievements, and
15 continued contributions of these institutions and organizations.
