A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Mr. Jimmy "Lord" Brown and dedicating an intersection in his honor; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Jimmy "Lord" Brown has long been recognized for his musical talents and
4 unique sound; and

5 WHEREAS, he is the founding member and master horn player for Brick, a legendary funk
6 and rhythm and blues band whose innovative blend of jazz, funk, and dance has left a lasting
7 impact on American music; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Brown's energy on the saxophone, flute, trumpet, and trombone created the
9 unmistakable brass-driven energy behind the band's hits, *Dusic*, *Ain't Gonna Hurt Nobody*,
10 and *Happy*; and

11 WHEREAS, his music stands as a symbol of funk excellence, cultural pride, and musical
12 innovation; and

13 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
14 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an intersection in his honor.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
16 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 204 and Middleground Road
17 in Chatham County is dedicated as the Jimmy "Lord" Brown Intersection.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
19 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Jimmy "Lord" Brown
20 Intersection.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
22 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Mr.
23 Jimmy "Lord" Brown and to the Department of Transportation.
