A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Lambda Theta Alpha Sorority, Inc.'s, Alpha Sigma Alumnae Chapter's Mujeres
2 Day at the Capitol on March 18, 2026; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Lambda Theta Alpha Latin Sorority, Inc., was established on December 1,
4 1975, at Kean University with the principles of unity, love, and respect; and

5 WHEREAS, Lambda Theta Alpha was founded by seventeen visionary trailblazers who
6 endeavored to create a supportive, empowering environment in which young women could
7 thrive, and whose steadfast determination laid the groundwork for an organization that
8 continues to celebrate Latino culture while promoting academic achievement, leadership, and
9 service; and

10 WHEREAS, a sisterhood that pushed boundaries and paved the way as the first Latina
11 sorority in the nation, Lambda Theta Alpha has become one of the first and largest Latina
12 sororities in the United States, celebrating 50 years of excellence scholarly excellence,
13 empowerment of the universal woman, political and cultural awareness and community
14 activism; and

15 WHEREAS, members of Lambda Theta Alpha in Georgia remain deeply committed to civic
16 engagement, leadership, and advocacy, hosting "Mujeres Day at the Capitol," organized by
17 the Alpha Sigma Alumnae Chapter since 2019 to train women of all backgrounds in the
18 practice of advocacy and to deepen their understanding of the legislative process; and

19 WHEREAS, Mujeres Day at the Capitol has also received national recognition, earning
20 Alpha Sigma Alumnae Chapter the distinguished honor of the 2025 Lambda Theta Alpha
21 Political Chapter of the Year, presented by the sorority's national organization in recognition
22 of the chapter's outstanding commitment to civic engagement; and

23 WHEREAS, throughout nearly five decades, Lambda Theta Alpha has gained over 10,000
24 members, faithfully upheld its praiseworthy mission to foster a strong sense of sisterhood,
25 advance educational excellence, and create opportunities for personal and professional
26 growth; and

27 WHEREAS, Lambda Theta Alpha proudly includes eight chapters in Georgia Area One
28 Undergraduate Chapters including Emory University- Gamma Nu Chapter, Georgia Institute
29 of Technology- Gamma Omega Chapter, The University of Georgia- Delta Alpha Chapter,
30 Georgia State University- Delta Beta Chapter, Kennesaw State University - Epsilon Alpha
31 Chapter, University of West Georgia- Zeta Beta Chapter, Oglethorpe University-Eta Xi
32 Chapter, and the Alpha Sigma Alumnae Chapter of Atlanta, Georgia; and

33 WHEREAS, it is altogether fitting and proper that the General Assembly recognize and
34 acknowledge Lambda Theta Alpha and affirm its importance to its members and all who
35 have benefited from its empowerment, mentorship, and support.

36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
37 the members of this body recognize Lambda Theta Alpha Sorority, Inc.'s, Alpha Sigma
38 Alumnae Chapter's Mujeres Day at the Capitol on March 18, 2026.
