A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and congratulating Elana Meyers Taylor; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Elana Meyers Taylor, who grew up in Douglasville, Georgia, is a six time
3 Olympic medalist in bobsled and one of the most accomplished athletes in the sport's history;

- 5 WHEREAS, following her successful career as a softball player at George Washington
6 University, Elana began competing in the two-woman bobsled event in 2007, before
7 expanding into the monobob event during the 2020-2021 World Cup season; and
- 8 WHEREAS, upon her bobsled debut, she immediately made the United States National
9 Team, quickly putting her on the path to becoming one of the most decorated women in
10 bobsled history; and
- 11 WHEREAS, currently, she competes at the highest level in both disciplines, demonstrating
12 her remarkable versatility and unwavering commitment to excellence; and
- 13 WHEREAS, she made her Olympic debut at the 2010 Vancouver Olympics and has
14 competed in every Games since then, consistently finishing on the podium each time; and

15 WHEREAS, over the course of her career, she has captured six Olympic, 12 World
16 Championship, and 14 international medals, cementing her reputation as an undisputed
17 legend in the bobsledding community; and

18 WHEREAS, at the 2026 Winter Olympics, in Milan-Cortina, Italy, she took home her first
19 gold medal at the age of 41; and

20 WHEREAS, her outstanding achievements continue to shine a spotlight on the State of
21 Georgia in the international sports community and serve as an inspiration to the next
22 generation of winter sports athletes from the state.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body recognize Elana Meyers Taylor for her many contributions to the
25 sport of bobsled, congratulate her upon winning her first Olympic gold medal, and extend
26 their sincere best wishes for her continued health, happiness, and success.
