A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Gwinnett County Public Schools; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Gwinnett County Public Schools, the largest school district in the State of
3 Georgia, serves nearly 180,000 students and is guided by a vision to become a system of
4 world-class schools wherein each and every student acquires the academic knowledge and
5 skills necessary to succeed in college, careers, and life; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Gwinnett County Public Schools remains steadfast in its commitment to
7 pursuing excellence in academic knowledge, skills, and behavior for every student while
8 ensuring that students remain at the center of every decision made in support of teaching and
9 learning; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the students, educators, staff, families, and community partners of Gwinnett
11 County Public Schools represent one of the most diverse and dynamic school communities
12 in this state and exemplify the strength, resilience, and promise of public education; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the district continues to advance rigorous and relevant learning opportunities
14 through academics, career and technical education, fine arts, athletics, and specialized

15 support services designed to prepare students for success in a rapidly evolving global society;

17 WHEREAS, the continued success of Gwinnett County Public Schools reflects a shared
18 commitment among educators, families, community partners, and public leaders to foster
19 safe, supportive, and engaging learning environments that expand opportunity and empower
20 every student to reach his or her full potential; and

21 WHEREAS, Gwinnett County Public Schools Capitol Day at the Georgia State Capitol
22 provides an important opportunity for students, educators, board members, and community
23 stakeholders to engage with members of the Georgia General Assembly, celebrate the
24 accomplishments of the district, and highlight the critical role of public education in

27 students to see themselves as future leaders who will contribute to the continued growth,
28 prosperity, and success of the State of Georgia.
