15 leadership positions across multiple sectors, including Senior Director of Corporate  
16 Engagement at Georgia Tech, Senior Director of Global Business Development at the Metro

19 generosity, reliability, and compassion for others, and his life was defined by the love he  
20 carried for his friends and family; and
