**AS PASSED SENATE**

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the State Court of Clayton County, approved January 28, 1964  
 2 (Ga. L. 1964, p. 2032), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 18, 2022 (Ga. L.  
 3 2022, p. 5510), so as to revise provisions related to the compensation of the solicitor-general  
 4 of the state court; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other  
 5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act creating the State Court of Clayton County, approved January 28, 1964  
 9 (Ga. L. 1964, p. 2032), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 18, 2022 (Ga. L.  
 10 2022, p. 5510), is amended by revising Section 6 as follows:

11 "SECTION 6.

12 Salary of the solicitor-general.

13 (a) The solicitor-general of the State Court of Clayton County shall receive a salary equal  
 14 to 95 percent of the total compensation of the Chief Judge of the State Court of Clayton  
 15 County, to include any supplement received pursuant to state law or county ordinance to  
 16 be paid in biweekly installments from the funds of Clayton County.

17 (b) In no event shall the solicitor-general's total salary as provided for in subsection (a) of  
18 this section exceed the greater of \$191,007.00 or 95 percent of the total compensation of  
19 the Chief Judge of the State Court of Clayton County."
