- 1 Recognizing and commending Carys Code; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Carys Code is student-athlete from Calgary, Alberta, Canada, majoring in
3 business with concentrations in finance and accounting at Goizueta Business School, and
4 minoring in economics at Emory College; and
- 5 WHEREAS, she has been playing golf competitively for the last five years, demonstrating
6 integrity, hard work, and discipline; and
- 7 WHEREAS, an analytical and detail-oriented young woman, Carys is motivated by
8 challenges and new learning opportunities, allowing her to excel in academics, on the golf
9 course, and in her extracurriculars; and
- 10 WHEREAS, her athletic resume includes but is not limited to: earning the 2025 NCAA
11 Division III Individual Champion, WGCA Southeast All-Region, WGCA Scholar
12 All-American, and All-UAA First Team Honors; playing on the CSC Academic All-America
13 First Team and WGCA All-America First Team; as well as playing in 10 tournaments at the
14 UAA Championships this season, averaging 75.4 across 25 rounds of competition, shooting

15 a season-low of 70 in the third round at the NCAA Championships, and finishing in the
16 top-50 in each event before winning the NCAA Championships; and

17 WHEREAS, Carys became the second Emory Eagle in program history to win the individual
18 national title with her NCAA record breaking performance; and

19 WHEREAS, she established herself in the NCAA history books as well established an
20 NCAA DIII championship record with her four-day total of 285 beating Carnegie Mellon's
21 Cecilia Jia by two strokes; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper to honor the outstanding achievements of this
23 remarkable student-athlete.

25 the members of this body recognize and commend Carys Code and extend their sincere best
26 wishes for her continued health, happiness, and success.
