- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Jason Hughes; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Jason Hughes was known as a devoted husband, dedicated father, and a
5 passionate teacher, mentor, and coach who was loved and respected by the students and staff
6 of North Hall High School, where he taught mathematics and coached golf; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Laura, and was blessed with two
8 exceptional sons; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Jason Hughes gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and
10 deep Christian faith, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
11 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in a message to the community, the Hughes family expressed gratitude for the
13 outpouring of prayers and support and asked that continued prayers be offered for their

14 family and for the students involved in the accident and their families, while also
15 encouraging all to extend grace and mercy to them as Christ has done for us; and

16 WHEREAS, colleagues, students, and friends remember Jason Hughes for his warm
17 personality, genuine kindness, and welcoming spirit, noting that whenever someone needed
18 help he was always willing to talk, always wearing a friendly smile and making others feel
19 valued and encouraged; and

20 WHEREAS, Jason Hughes will long be remembered for his love of family, friendship, and
21 community and will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
