## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing March 26, 2026, as We Are CASA Day at the state capitol; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, We Are CASA is a Georgia organization that unifies immigrant and  
4 working-class families to build power and improve the quality of life in Black, Latino/a/e,  
5 Afro-descendent, Indigenous, and immigrant communities; and

6 WHEREAS, We Are CASA is an individual membership organization with more than 450  
7 members in Georgia, dozens of whom come to the state capitol on a regular basis; and

8 WHEREAS, We Are CASA creates change in communities by blending human services,  
9 community organizing, and advocacy in order to serve the full spectrum of the needs,  
10 dreams, and aspirations of its members; and

11 WHEREAS, We Are CASA unites community members for advocacy campaigns such as  
12 tenants rights following the passage of HB 404 and student safety in the wake of increasing  
13 federal enforcement actions across the state; and

14 WHEREAS, We Are CASA, in the last year alone, has equipped over 400 people with health  
15 insurance through a partnership with Kaiser Permanente; and

16 WHEREAS, We Are CASA members contribute to their local communities by filling  
17 essential jobs, growing faith-based communities, engaging in their children's schools, and  
18 fighting to ensure their housing rights and those of their neighbors are respected; and

19 WHEREAS, We Are CASA's staff provide access to health services, English classes, "Know  
20 Your Rights" seminars, and legal clinics with the help of partner non-profits and the private  
21 bar; and

22 WHEREAS, We Are CASA, through their C4, We Are CASA Action, has helped register  
23 over 1,400 new voters and engaged hundreds of voters at their doors; and

24 WHEREAS, the members of We Are CASA are people who have chosen Georgia as their  
25 home; a state where they are buying homes, growing businesses, raising children, and  
26 contributing to the culture and economy of our state.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
28 the members of this body recognize March 26, 2026, as We Are CASA Day at the state  
29 capitol.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
31 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
32 public and the press.
