A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Rasheeda Frost; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Rasheeda Frost is an American rapper, television personality, and entrepreneur
3 who rose to prominence in the Southern hip-hop scene before becoming a major reality-TV
4 figure and businesswoman; and

5 WHEREAS, Rasheeda was born in Decatur, Illinois, and moved to Atlanta at age 14, where
6 she began developing her music career and entered the music scene as a member of the
7 female hip-hop trio Da Kaperz, which gained attention in Atlanta during the late 1990s; and

8 WHEREAS, her early exposure to Atlanta's rapidly growing hip-hop culture helped shape
9 her sound and business mindset, which would later define her brand as a "boss chick"
10 entrepreneur and artist; and

11 WHEREAS, after departing from the female hip-hop trio Da Kaperz, Rasheeda launched her
12 solo career in 2000 and quickly established herself as a prominent voice in Southern hip-hop,
13 gaining widespread recognition for hit records ,including "Do It," "Type of Girl," "My
14 Bubble Gum," "Vibrate," and "Marry Me"; and

15 WHEREAS, in 2001, she released her debut album *Dirty South*, featuring collaborations with
16 artists such as Nelly and Pastor Troy, solidifying her presence in the industry; and

17 WHEREAS, she followed up in 2002 with *A Ghetto Dream*, an independent release under
18 her own label, D-Lo Entertainment, showcasing her early business acumen; and

19 WHEREAS, Rasheeda continued to build her catalog with subsequent projects including *GA*
20 *Peach* (2006), *Dat Type of Gurl* (2007), *Certified Hot Chick* (2009), and *Boss Chick Music*
21 (2012), further cementing her legacy as both an independent artist and a trailblazing
22 entrepreneur in hip-hop; and

23 WHEREAS, in 2012, Rasheeda joined the cast of *Love & Hip Hop: Atlanta*, which follows
24 the careers and personal lives of Atlanta's music industry figures; the show dramatically
25 increased her visibility, documenting her music career, entrepreneurial ventures, as well as
26 her marriage and business partnership with Kirk Frost; and

27 WHEREAS, beyond music and television, Rasheeda has built a strong reputation as a serial
28 entrepreneur, successfully expanding her brand across multiple industries; and

29 WHEREAS, her business ventures include Pressed Boutique, a popular fashion retail store
30 with locations in Atlanta and Houston; Poiz Cosmetics, her beauty and makeup line; Frost
31 Bistro & Bar, an Atlanta-based restaurant she co-owns with her husband Kirk Frost; and
32 service on the board for Herbal Honesty, a health and wellness herbal brand; and

33 WHEREAS, through her strategic ability to leverage her television platform into thriving
34 business opportunities, Rasheeda has established herself as a respected Black female
35 entrepreneur in both the entertainment and retail spaces; and

36 WHEREAS, her journey reflects resilience, reinvention, and a sharp business mindset,
37 allowing her to remain relevant across evolving generations of culture and media; and

38 WHEREAS, today, Rasheeda stands as a blueprint for independent success, continuing to
39 inspire aspiring artists and entrepreneurs alike by proving that longevity in the industry is
40 built not just on talent, but on ownership, vision, and the ability to evolve.

41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
42 the members of this body recognize and commend Rasheeda Frost for her invaluable
43 contributions to the communities she has served.
