## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the Natural Gas Association of Georgia's 10th anniversary; and for other purposes.

3 municipalities that provide natural gas services to the residents of Georgia; and

16 Southstar Energy Services, and David Martin with Mansfield Power and Gas were nominated  
17 to be the Everyday Energy Heroes for 2025; and
