## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Phillip Cortez Gable; and for other purposes.

3 with the passing of Phillip Cortez Gable, affectionately known as "Corkey," a devoted family  
4 man, respected professional, and proud patriot; and

5 WHEREAS, Phillip Cortez Gable was born on March 13, 1948, in Braselton, Georgia, and  
6 he passed away on March 9, 2026, in Atlanta, Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, he honorably served in the United States Army from 1968 to 1971, faithfully  
8 answering the call to serve his country; and

9 WHEREAS, he enjoyed a distinguished career as Vice President at the Bank of Ozarks,  
10 earning the respect of colleagues through his leadership, integrity, and commitment to
