### A RESOLUTION

4 County employs 49 Social Workers through its Department of Family and Children's  
5 Services; and

7 basic needs of all people, especially the most vulnerable in our society; and

8 WHEREAS, Social Workers follow a Code of Ethics that calls on them to fight social  
9 injustice and respect the dignity and worth of all people; and

11 reach their full potential; and

13 and in a variety of places, including schools, hospitals, the military, child welfare agencies,

15 WHEREAS, Social Workers have helped people cope with death and grief and communities  
16 recover from natural disasters, including hurricanes, drought, and flooding; and

17 WHEREAS, Social Workers are the largest group of mental healthcare providers in the  
18 United States, working daily to help thousands of Americans overcome mental illness.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body commend Paulding County's social workers during this year's  
21 National Social Worker Month for their outstanding service on behalf of those in need as  
22 well as extend best wishes for continued success.
