## A RESOLUTION

1 Designating April as National Black Women's History Month; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, National Black Women's History Month is a time to honor the rich heritage,  
3 resilience, and achievements of Black Women who have positively shaped the United States;  
4 and

5 WHEREAS, Black Women have played a pivotal role in advancing resilience,  
6 empowerment, and faith; and

7 WHEREAS, the month of April will specifically highlight the experiences, achievements,  
8 and unique contributions of Black Women throughout history; and

9 WHEREAS, National Black Women's History Month is designed to unify the community  
10 by promoting visibility, education, empowerment, contribution, and achievement, all of  
11 which positively impact communities across the globe; and

12 WHEREAS, the theme for the 2026 celebration of National Black Women's History Month  
13 is "Black Women: Sharing our Stories, Honoring Our Legacies" which conveys

14 empowerment through storytelling, preservation of history and culture, celebration of  
15 resilience, strength, and influence; and

16 WHEREAS, by recognizing and respecting the impact Black Women have made across  
17 generations culturally, socially, politically, and personally, this month will acknowledge how  
18 those women shaped the present.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body recognize April as National Black Women's History Month.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
22 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
23 public and the press.
