A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Impact Georgia Day and honoring distinguished Georgians for their
2 contributions to the state and beyond; and for other purposes.

4 have made a lasting impact on their communities and the state as a whole; and

5 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia has long been home to individuals whose leadership,
6 innovation, and service have strengthened communities and inspired future generations; and

7 WHEREAS, recognizing these individuals fosters pride, unity, and a shared commitment to
8 progress within our communities; and

10 represented the State of Georgia on a global stage as entertainers, entrepreneurs, and
11 philanthropists, including Jasiel Amon Robinson, also known as Yung Joc, a Grammy
12 Award-winning artist and actor; Karlie Lewis, also known as Karlie Redd, an accomplished
13 television personality and recording artist; and Nehemiah Davis, a renowned motivational
14 speaker and philanthropist; and

16 courage in breaking barriers and creating opportunities for others; and

17 WHEREAS, their efforts have paved the way for future generations of Georgians to dream
