## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing March 31, 2026, as Morrow Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, located in Clayton County, Georgia, the City of Morrow is best known for its  
3 retail centers, educational institutions, and importance as part of the Atlanta metropolitan  
4 area; and

5 WHEREAS, the city was formally incorporated in 1943, and it has since grown to cover an  
6 area of between three and four square miles as well as a population of nearly 8,000 residents;  
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the city is home to Clayton State University, a major public school known for  
9 its exceptional business, nursing, and aviation programs as well as Spivey Hall, a cherished  
10 concert venue; and

11 WHEREAS, the Southlake Mall is one of the largest shopping centers on Atlanta's south  
12 side, and retail along Mount Zion Road and Jonesboro Road constitutes the majority of the  
13 city's commercial activity; and

14 WHEREAS, the city further serves as host to numerous local events and civic activities  
15 throughout the year, including community festivals, business ribbon cuttings, cultural  
16 celebrations, and recognition ceremonies; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable city be appropriately  
18 honored during this special time.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body recognize March 31, 2026, as Morrow Day at the state capitol and  
21 extend best wishes for future health, happiness, and success to the citizens of the City of  
22 Morrow.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
24 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
25 public and the press.
