A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Deputy Nicolas Glass for his courageous and valiant service
2 in the line of duty; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Deputy Nicolas Glass has faithfully served the citizens of Cherokee County as
4 a member of the Cherokee County Sheriff's Office since May 2022; and

5 WHEREAS, in April 2025, Deputy Glass transferred to Uniform Patrol, and after
6 successfully completing the Field Training Program, he was assigned to the Oak Grove
7 Precinct in July 2025, where he has already demonstrated remarkable dedication by
8 responding to over 1,100 calls for service and serving as the reporting officer on more than
9 180 cases and incidents; and

10 WHEREAS, on the evening of October 25, 2025, Deputy Glass responded alongside fellow
11 deputies to a welfare check involving a missing adult female, demonstrating his commitment
12 to protecting the well-being of the citizens he serves; and

13 WHEREAS, during the course of that response, Deputy Glass encountered a violent and
14 life-threatening situation when an armed assailant attacked him with a knife, striking him

15 across the face and continuing the assault as Deputy Glass attempted to retreat and defend
16 himself; and

17 WHEREAS, despite sustaining injuries and facing imminent danger, Deputy Glass exhibited
18 extraordinary courage, composure, and presence of mind by defending himself and alerting
19 fellow deputies, actions which ultimately contributed to stopping the threat and preventing
20 further harm; and

21 WHEREAS, subsequent investigation revealed that the incident was connected to a tragic
22 homicide within the residence, further underscoring the dangerous and unpredictable nature
23 of the situation confronted by Deputy Glass; and

24 WHEREAS, the actions of Deputy Nicolas Glass reflect great credit upon himself, the
25 Cherokee County Sheriff's Office, and the State of Georgia, serving as a powerful reminder
26 of the sacrifices made daily by law enforcement officers to protect and serve their
27 communities.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
29 recognize and commend Deputy Nicolas Glass for his courageous and valiant efforts in the
30 line of duty and extend their deepest gratitude for his service to the citizens of Cherokee
31 County and the State of Georgia.

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
33 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to Deputy Nicolas
34 Glass.
