A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Center for Black Women's Wellness; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, over the past 36 years, the Center for Black Women's Wellness has served
4 women, men, and children throughout metropolitan Atlanta through a host of programs and
5 services aimed at optimizing health, strengthening families and communities, and advancing
6 health equity; and

7 WHEREAS, the Center for Black Women's Wellness was initially established in 1988 as a
8 program under the National Black Women's Health Project with the purpose of conducting
9 self-help group development in public housing and developing resiliency among low-income
10 women; and

11 WHEREAS, in 1996, the center incorporated as an independent nonprofit organization, and
12 it has since worked to provide individuals in need with the physical, mental, emotional, and
13 financial support necessary to live full and productive lives; and

14 WHEREAS, the exceptional staff, volunteers, and partners of the Center for Black Women's
15 Wellness dedicate innumerable hours of their time and energy toward upholding the center's
16 mission and supporting communities throughout metro Atlanta; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this exemplary organization be
18 appropriately honored during this special time.

20 the members of this body recognize and commend the Center for Black Women's Wellness
