- 2 WHEREAS, Elizabeth Garcia is a proud first-generation college student, undergraduate  
3 researcher, and dedicated community leader; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a student at Emory University, Elizabeth is one of only two Latina students in  
5 the Class of 2026 computer science program as well as the First Latina undergraduate  
6 researcher for the Atlanta Interdisciplinary Artificial Intelligence Network (AIAI Network);

- 8 WHEREAS, as the founder and co-president of the Emory University chapter of ColorStack,  
9 a nonprofit organization that supports Black and Latinx students pursuing careers in  
10 computer science and technology, Elizabeth has tirelessly provided community as well as  
11 academic and professional support and guidance to her peers; and
- 12 WHEREAS, within her community, Elizabeth has worked with Lucky Shoals Community  
13 Association to help deliver and create bilingual health education initiatives and  
14 neighborhood-centered health programming; and

15 WHEREAS, she has also worked with Georgia Representative Marvin Lim to ensure  
16 community members are aware of available resources as well as volunteered as a Spanish  
17 Medical Interpreter at the Good Samaritan Health Center of Atlanta; and

18 WHEREAS, following her graduation Elizabeth hopes to pursue a career at the intersection  
19 of technology, artificial intelligence, digital humanities, and public service, using technology  
20 and research to support communities and expand access to knowledge and resources.
