- 5 WHEREAS, Christian traditions and biblical values are the bedrock of the United States

- 7 WHEREAS, Holy Week is celebrated by Christians annually as a reminder of the atoning
8 death and victorious resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Son of God; and
- 9 WHEREAS, God has made us in His image, (mind, body, spirit) like the Father, Son, and

- 11 WHEREAS, there is no other God than the God of the Holy Bible.
