## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Danny Hall; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Danny Hall began his exemplary coaching career as a graduate assistant at his  
3 alma mater, Miami University, from 1978 to 1979, and he continued to develop his expertise  
4 over eight seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Michigan; and

5 WHEREAS, he earned his first head coaching position at Kent State University, serving from  
6 1988 to 1993 and leading the program to two Mid-American Conference championships  
7 while receiving recognition as a two-time Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year; and

8 WHEREAS, in 1994, Danny Hall became the head coach at the Georgia Institute of  
9 Technology, where over 32 seasons he built one of the most successful programs in  
10 collegiate baseball history and compiled a remarkable 1,244-676 record; and

11 WHEREAS, under his leadership, the Georgia Tech baseball program captured eight Atlantic  
12 Coast Conference regular-season championships and five Atlantic Coast Conference  
13 Tournament championships, earned 25 NCAA Tournament appearances, and advanced to  
14 three College World Series appearances; and

15 WHEREAS, his commitment to the development of student-athletes is evidenced by his  
16 mentorship of 149 Georgia Tech players who were selected in the Major League Baseball  
17 Draft a total of 166 times, as well as 15 Georgia Tech players who earned Academic  
18 All-America recognition a combined 19 times; and

19 WHEREAS, throughout his distinguished career, Danny Hall amassed an overall head  
20 coaching record of 1,452-793-1, ranking ninth in NCAA history for career victories; and

21 WHEREAS, his exceptional leadership and impact on the game have been recognized  
22 through numerous honors, including his induction into the American Baseball Coaches Hall  
23 of Fame in 2023 and his designation as an honorary alumnus of the Georgia Institute of  
24 Technology in 2024; and

25 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this exemplary individual be  
26 appropriately honored during this special time.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
28 the members of this body commend Danny Hall for his decades of exceptional service in  
29 collegiate baseball as well as extend best wishes for future health and happiness.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
