A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Jennifer Boger for her distinguished career in public service
2 and her time in the Georgia State Senate Budget and Evaluation Office; and for other
3 purposes.

5 specializing in budgetary and financial analysis across many governmental institutions; and

6 WHEREAS, she began her career with the Pennsylvania State Treasury Department as an
7 accounting assistant from 1991 to 1997, establishing her strong foundation in fiscal
8 responsibility and public finance; and

9 WHEREAS, she continued her service with the Pennsylvania Senate Appropriations
10 Committee as a budget analyst from 2000 to 2010, later advancing to senior budget analyst
11 and continuing her work with the Pennsylvania Independent Fiscal Office; and

13 financial management with the Pennsylvania Auditor General from 2015 to 2019; and

16 Courts, before joining the Georgia State Senate Budget and Evaluation Office in 2023 as a
17 principal program analyst; and

18 WHEREAS, throughout her tenure with the Georgia State Senate, Jennifer Boger has built
19 strong and lasting relationships with members of the Senate, leadership, and colleagues,
20 earning trust and respect through her professionalism and dedication; and

21 WHEREAS, she is a proud graduate of Penn State University, holding both a Bachelor of
22 Science and a Master of Public Administration; and

23 WHEREAS, her greatest joys are her children—Jacob, Kennedy, and Rylan—who have been
24 her constant sources of support and pride throughout her career; and

25 WHEREAS, known for her sharp analytical skills, quick thinking, and unwavering
26 commitment to government service, she has also become beloved among colleagues for her
27 constant kindness and joyful spirit; and

28 WHEREAS, as a resident of Atlanta who will soon be departing, her presence and
29 contributions will be deeply missed by all who have had the privilege of working alongside
30 her.
