A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Per Scholas Atlanta on the occasion of its 10th anniversary; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Per Scholas is a national nonprofit organization dedicated to advancing
4 economic mobility through rigorous no-cost technology training, professional development,
5 and employer connections for individuals from communities; and

6 WHEREAS, Per Scholas Atlanta was established in 2016 to expand access to high-quality
7 technology education and career pathways for residents across the greater Atlanta region; and

8 WHEREAS, since its founding, Per Scholas Atlanta has enrolled more than 2,000 learners,
9 equipping them with the skills, certifications, and support needed to launch careers in the
10 technology sector and helping to close the opportunity gap; and

11 WHEREAS, Per Scholas Atlanta offers industry-aligned training programs in high-demand
12 fields, including AWS cloud computing, cybersecurity, IT support, software engineering,
13 data center operations, low voltage technician training, and Salesforce administration,
14 preparing learners for success in a rapidly evolving digital economy; and

15 WHEREAS, in 2025, Per Scholas Atlanta achieved an 81 percent certification attainment
16 rate, demonstrating the effectiveness and rigor of its training programs; and

17 WHEREAS, the organization provides comprehensive wraparound supports—including
18 career coaching, job placement assistance, and professional skills development—to ensure
19 learners are equipped to overcome barriers and achieve long-term success; and

20 WHEREAS, Per Scholas Atlanta collaborates with employer partners, community-based
21 organizations, and public sector leaders to build a strong, diverse pipeline of technology
22 talent and support regional workforce development; and

23 WHEREAS, in 2026, Per Scholas Atlanta proudly celebrates its 10-year anniversary,
24 marking a decade of transformative impact and continued dedication to empowering
25 individuals and strengthening communities through technology training.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
27 the members of this body commend Per Scholas Atlanta for its outstanding service to the
28 people of Georgia and celebrate its 10 years of impact in expanding access to opportunity
29 and building a diverse, skilled technology workforce.
