## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Bob Blackburn; and for other purposes.

4 of the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,

7 dramatically by his nearly 14 years of superlative service as Coweta County District 3
