A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing March 31, 2026, as Underserved Communities Day at the state capitol; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper to recognize Community Estr(EI/La) for their
4 work and service in educating communities about the challenges and contributions of
5 underserved Georgians; and

6 WHEREAS, Community Estr(EI/La) is a community-based organization underserved
7 individuals who are dedicated to defending, organizing, and empowering the human rights
8 of underserved Georgians, including racial minorities, victims of domestic violence, sexual
9 minorities, indigenous peoples, immigrants, and others; and

10 WHEREAS, Underserved Communities Day is a significant observance dedicated to
11 recognizing the struggles and celebrating the achievements of underserved communities; and

12 WHEREAS, these communities have faced historical and ongoing challenges, including
13 violence, discrimination, and injustice; and

14 WHEREAS, recognizing Underserved Communities Day serves as an opportunity to foster
15 understanding, inclusivity, and acceptance within our state.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body recognize March 31, 2026, as Underserved Communities Day at
18 the state capitol.

20 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
21 public and the press.
