

Senator Kemp of the 38th offered the following amendment #1:

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on State and Local Governmental Operations - General*
2 *substitute to HB 309 (LC 62 0525S) by replacing "and Title 36" on line 1 with the following:*
3 Title 50, and Title 36

4 *By inserting between "definitions;" and "to" on line 17 the following:*
5 to amend Code Section 50-14-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
6 meetings open to the public, limitation on action to contest agency action, recording, notice
7 of time and place, access to minutes, and teleconference, so as to revise a provision
8 authorizing community service boards to conduct teleconference meetings under certain
9 circumstances;

10 *By inserting between lines 259 and 260 the following:*
11 Code Section 50-14-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to meetings open
12 to the public, limitation on action to contest agency action, recording, notice of time and
13 place, access to minutes, and teleconference, is amended by revising subparagraph (A) of
14 paragraph (1) of subsection (h) as follows:

15 "(h)(1) The following bodies and committees thereof shall be authorized to conduct
16 meetings by teleconference, provided that any such meeting shall be considered to be
17 conducted in compliance with this chapter so long as the notice required by this chapter
18 is provided and, if fewer than a quorum of the members of a body or committee thereof
19 are physically present, means have been afforded for the public to have simultaneous
20 access to the teleconference meeting:

21 (A) ~~Development~~ Authorities created pursuant to or authorized by the provisions of
22 Chapter 41 or Chapter 61 of Title 36, development authorities created pursuant to or
23 authorized by the provisions of Chapter 42 or Chapter 62 of Title 36, by or pursuant to
24 Article IX, Section VI, Paragraph III of the Georgia Constitution, or by or pursuant to
25 any amendment to the Constitution continued pursuant to the authority of Article XI,
26 Section I, Paragraph IV of the Constitution;"
