

MOOT

Senators Kirkpatrick of the 32nd, Parent of the 44th, and Robertson of the 29th offered the following amendment #1:

1 *Amend the House Committee on Agriculture and Consumer Affairs substitute to SB 33*
 2 *(LC 44 3506S) by inserting "to provide for compliance with federal rules and regulations;"*
 3 *after "so as" on line 2.*

4 *By replacing "paragraph (3)" with "paragraphs (3), (11), (14), and (16)" on line 15.*

5 *By inserting after line 20 the following:*

6 "(3.5) 'Container' means the innermost wrapping, packaging, or vessel in direct contact
 7 with a consumable hemp product in which the final such product is enclosed for retail
 8 sale to consumers, including a jar, bottle, bag, box, packet, can, carton, or cartridge. Such
 9 term does not include bulk shipping containers or outer wrappings that are not essential
 10 for the final retail delivery or sale to an end consumer for personal or household use."

11 "(11) 'Hemp' means the Cannabis sativa L. plant and any part of such plant, including the
 12 seeds thereof and all derivatives, extracts, cannabinoids, isomers, acids, salts, and salts
 13 of isomers, whether growing or not, with a total ~~delta-9-THC~~ THC concentration that
 14 does not exceed the legal limit. Such term does not include:

15 (A) Any viable seeds from a Cannabis sativa L. plant that exceed a total
 16 tetrahydrocannabinols concentration, including tetrahydrocannabinolic acid of 0.3
 17 percent in the plant on a dry weight basis;

18 (B) Any intermediate hemp derived cannabinoid product containing:

19 (i) Cannabinoids that are not capable of being naturally produced by a Cannabis
 20 sativa L. plant;

21 (ii) Cannabinoids that:

- 22 (I) Are capable of being naturally produced by a Cannabis sativa L. plant; and
23 (II) Were synthesized or manufactured outside the plant; or
24 (iii) Constitute more than a 0.3 percent combined total of:
25 (I) Total tetrahydrocannabinols, including tetrahydrocannabinolic acid; and
26 (II) Any other cannabinoids that have similar effects or are marketed to have
27 similar effects on humans or animals as a tetrahydrocannabinol;
28 (C) Any intermediate hemp derived cannabinoid products which are marketed to be
29 sold as a final product or directly to an end consumer for personal or household use; or
30 (D) Any consumable hemp products containing:
31 (i) Cannabinoids that are not capable of being naturally produced by a Cannabis
32 sativa L. plant;
33 (ii) Cannabinoids that:
34 (I) Are capable of being naturally produced by a Cannabis sativa L. plant; and
35 (II) Were synthesized or manufactured outside the plant; or
36 (iii) Greater than 0.4 milligram combined total per container of:
37 (I) Total tetrahydrocannabinols, including tetrahydrocannabinolic acid; and
38 (II) Any other cannabinoids that have similar effects or are marketed to have
39 similar effects on humans or animals as a tetrahydrocannabinol."
40 "(14) 'Industrial hemp product' means any hemp product that is not a consumable hemp
41 product or an intermediate hemp derived cannabinoid product.
42 (14.5) 'Intermediate hemp derived cannabinoid product' means a hemp product other than
43 a consumable hemp product or an industrial hemp product which:
44 (A) Is not yet in the final form or preparation and is marketed or intended to be used
45 or consumed by a human or animal; or
46 (B) Is a powder, liquid, tablet, oil, or other product which is marketed or intended to
47 be mixed, dissolved, formulated, or otherwise added to or prepared with or into any
48 other substance prior to administration or consumption."

- 49 "(16) 'Legal limit' means a total ~~delta-9-THC~~ THC concentration that is the lesser of:
- 50 (A) 0.3 percent; or
- 51 (B) The percentage limit set forth in 7 U.S.C. Section 1639o."
