A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Carolyn H. Rambert; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, born and raised in Macon, Georgia, Carolyn H. Rambert began her education
3 at L.H. Williams Elementary School and Unionville Elementary School before graduating
4 from Ballard-Hudson High School; and

5 WHEREAS, she continued her academic journey as a first generation college student at Fort
6 Valley State College and, following relocation due to her husband's military service, pursued
7 studies at Langston University in Langston, Oklahoma; and

8 WHEREAS, upon returning to Macon, she resumed her studies at Fort Valley State
9 University, where she earned a Bachelor of Science in elementary education; and

10 WHEREAS, she further advanced her education through additional studies at Ball State
11 University and the City Colleges of Chicago while residing abroad during her husband's
12 assignment at Torrejón Air Force Base in Spain, where she was hired by the Department of
13 Defense as an educator; and

14 WHEREAS, during her tenure as a Department of Defense educator, she continued her
15 professional development by earning a master's degree in early childhood education from
16 Mercer University; and

17 WHEREAS, she dedicated 30 years of service as an educator with the Department of
18 Defense, beginning her career in Spain and continuing a long and impactful career devoted
19 to the instruction and development of young learners; and

20 WHEREAS, in addition to her professional accomplishments, Carolyn H. Rambert was a
21 devoted member of Greater Vineville Baptist Church, where she served as Head of the Youth
22 Department, Secretary of Finance, and Head of the Care and Comfort Ministry; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
24 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately honored.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
26 the members of this body recognize and commend Carolyn H. Rambert for her decades of
27 exemplary service on behalf of her fellow citizens and extend the most sincere best wishes
