A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Sunnah Muhammad Pasha; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Sunnah Muhammad Pasha on June 5, 2026; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Sunnah Muhammad Pasha was born on December 24, 1974, in Cincinnati,
5 Ohio, a beloved son of Aldean and Daoud Pasha; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he received his early education at Sprayberry High School, graduating as part
7 of the Class of 1993, and he matriculated at Alabama A&M University, where he received
8 an internship with IBM Consulting Services and became a member of the Alpha Phi Alpha
9 Fraternity, Inc., Delta Gamma Chapter; and

11 Management Consulting, during which he rose to the pinnacle of corporate leadership and
