## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Sugarloaf Community Improvement District upon its 10th  
2 Anniversary; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Sugarloaf Community Improvement District was formed on May 17, 2016,  
4 and it now celebrates ten years of service to Gwinnett County and the State of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, the District has become an economic cornerstone of the region, home to 7  
6 percent of Gwinnett County's jobs and generating a remarkable \$15.4 billion annual  
7 economic impact on Georgia's economy; and

8 WHEREAS, the District is guided by a clear and inspiring mission: to create and maintain  
9 a connected, safe, and attractive business, arts, and entertainment district—a vibrant  
10 downtown for Gwinnett County; and

11 WHEREAS, over the past decade, the District has invested millions of dollars in lasting  
12 public improvements, including roadway and intersection projects, transit upgrades,  
13 sidewalks and trails, security cameras, landscaping enhancements, and signage and banners  
14 that beautify and strengthen the community; and

16 including one of the largest underpass murals in the country, transforming public spaces into  
17 sources of pride and inspiration; and

18 WHEREAS, through these investments in safety, connectivity, and beauty, the Sugarloaf  
19 Community Improvement District has advanced economic vitality, enhanced quality of life,  
20 and helped shape a vibrant downtown that serves residents, workers, and visitors alike  
21 throughout House District 96 and beyond.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
23 the members of this body recognize and commend the Sugarloaf Community Improvement  
24 District upon the grand occasion of its 10th Anniversary, express their gratitude for its  
25 outstanding contributions to Gwinnett County and the State of Georgia, and extend best  
26 wishes for continued success in the decade ahead.
